**BIOGRAPHY OF MR LIM MING YAN, CHAIRMAN OF SBF WITH EFFECT FROM 30 JUNE 2020**



Mr Lim Ming Yan is the Chairman of SBF with effect from 30 Jun 2020. He is also the Chairman of Workforce Singapore, a member of Singapore's Future Economy Council (FEC), Co-Chairman of FEC's Built Environment sub-committee, a member of FEC's Emerging Stronger Taskforce, a member of National Jobs Council, a board director of Business China, as well as a board trustee of Singapore Management University.

Mr Lim also sits on the boards of Singapore Press Holdings, Central China Real Estate Limited, and DLF Cyber City Developers Limited. In his 22 years at CapitaLand Limited, Mr Lim was President and Group CEO from 2013 to 2018, CEO of The Ascott Limited from 2009 to 2012 and CEO of CapitaLand China from 2000 to 2009.

Mr Lim graduated with a first-class honours degree in Mechanical Engineering and Economics from the University of Birmingham, United Kingdom in 1985. He also attended the Advanced Management Program at Harvard Business School in 2002.
